

REGULATIONS FOR USE THE AREA EQUIPPED FOR TEMPORARY PARKING FOR CAMPER AND CARAVANS SAN GIULIANO VENICE MESTRE LOCALITA' SAN GIULIANO – PORTA GIALLA

Welcome

We welcome you to the San Giuliano Venice Parking Area in Mestre VE Località San Giuliano Porta Gialla. To ensure the proper course of your stay and ensure the well-being of all guests of the structure, please take note of the following information and scrupulously observe the following rules. Guests and visitors are only allowed access to the facility by accepting these internal rules. The Regulation is deemed to be accepted at the time of entry.

Establishment of the San Giuliano Venice Equipped Parking Area

The equipped parking area has been established pursuant to art. 7 and 185 of D.lgs 285/1992 and art. 36 of the Law of the Veneto Region n.11/2013 with a special Resolution of the Extraordinary Commissioner of the Municipality of Venice assumed with the powers of the Municipal Board n.52 of 26.06.2015. The Municipality of Venice has subsequently, in accordance with current legislation, entrusted the management of the complex to third parties by means of a special agreement.

Description of the service

The services offered in the equipped parking area include:

- Approximately 100 parking spaces equipped with night lighting;
- Sewage/clear discharge and organic waste;
- Extractable chemical toilets;
- Loading drinking water;
- Full toilet facilities and disabled toilets with access platforms;
- Reception with operator at least 8 hours/day;
- Connection to the electricity grid for a fee;



- Video surveillance by cameras;
- Armed surveillance with patrol passes from 24.00 to 06.00;

General Limitations

- Only caravans and motorhomes falling within the definition of art.54 c.1.letter m of D. Lgs 285/1992 and art. 36 of the Law of the Veneto Region nr. 11/2013;
- Temporary stop is allowed for a maximum of 48 consecutive hours;
- It is absolutely forbidden to carry out any form of camping within the Equipped Area. According to the article 185 of the Road Code, it does not constitute camping if the vehicle rests on the ground only with wheels, does not emit own flows (except those of the mechanical engine) and does not occupy the relevant area in excess of the proper space of the vehicle itself. Therefore, it is not permitted to occupy the ground with other equipment, whether or not these are attached to the vehicle (such as tents, awnings, etc.) or to occupy the ground with objects, tools or equipment or other materials (Table, chairs, parasols, stoves, deck chairs, clothes-drying racks, etc.)

Rules of conduct

- It is forbidden to damage the area, its tree endowments and its structures/installations; It is forbidden to leave waste, flush vehicles outside the vehicle's pit, light fires, lay out cloths, expose cylinders, light barbecues etc. or other gear within the area; It is forbidden to commit any act/activity that may cause damage to people or things or involve waste of energy or drinking water;
- Waste must be separately collected in separate containers;
- Washing of vehicles is prohibited;
- Motor-driven generating sets shall not be switched on;
- It is forbidden to make noise, keep the volume of radio and television high;
- Entry and exit on foot or by bicycle is not prohibited at any time but must be carried out with the utmost respect;
- Washing of dishes and towels is only allowed in the appropriate washbasins and wash rooms;



- Pets are allowed only if guarded by the owners in order to avoid harassment, disturbance or damage to things and/ or people. The obligation to keep dogs on a leash and to collect their excrement is highlighted.

Rates

The fee for parking and use of services offered in the equipped area, established by a special measure of the City of Venice, is 18 euros per 24 hours of parking. There is also a special fee of 10 euros for the use of sanitary equipment for those in transit only who do not intend to stay in the area.

The above rates are given suitable and accurate information to the user through public display. The table of prices is displayed at the entrance in a visible way for the users. The payment of the daily rate not fractional allows the use of a stall for 24h or fraction from the actual time of entry until the same time of the next day. Payment must be made at the automatic cash desk in the outbound outlet for periods longer than 24 hours but within 48 hours. After payment, the exit can be made within a maximum of 10 minutes sufficient for the last transactions.

Waste water discharge standards

It is recalled that the operation must always be carried out in accordance with the most basic hygiene rules and good manners:

1. The vehicle must be positioned so that the exhaust pipe can be discharged in the best way;
2. Open the drain gate;
3. After unloading, move the vehicle to the designated parking space;
4. Clean the grill and remove any residue.

Rules for drinking water use

Avoid any form of waste. It is absolutely forbidden to use water for improper uses. The quantity of water that can be taken is proportional to the capacity of the tanks of the parked vehicle. It is absolutely forbidden to use water for washing the camper or for other uses than that of loading the tank.

Electricity use regulations

The connection to the power outlets of the supply columns can be activated after payment at the reception. The operator shall ensure the safety of electrical connections up to the final outlets or distribution box, and from that point onwards the responsibility for all connections and installed systems is entirely the user's.



Rules for parking the vehicle

The parking of trucks is allowed only in the appropriate stalls. It is forbidden to stop along the access and manoeuvre lanes or in any way not to hinder the exit maneuvers, entry of vehicles. It is forbidden to stop in the way of camper service.

Responsibility

The parking lot is not guarded. The manager is therefore exempt from any liability in respect of damage to things, even if left unattended outside the vehicle, and to persons; is also exempt from any liability for theft that occurs inside the vehicles parked in the area.

Sanctions

The violation of the above conditions may result, at the discretion of the manager, the immediate removal from the parking area of the offender by public authorities in case the non-compliance may have caused real material damage or constituted a crime.

In the case of a prolonged stop after 48 hours, the offender is not only required to pay the corresponding fee, but can also be sanctioned by the public authorities pursuant to art. 39 of the L.R. n. 16/2004 and art. 7 of the Code of the Road.
